<u> A note for all riders – Equine Corona Virus</u>

Recently my mare Charm contracted Equine Corona Virus (EcoV), it is spread by fecal - oral transmission and is a gastrointestinal illness that is shed in manure.

Signs and symptoms are high temperatures, loss of appetite, lethargy, diarrhea, mild colic, flank watching, lying down. It is a zoonotic disease so we can catch it and so can other animals. Care is intravenous fluids, fever reducing medications, gastrointestinal protectants, and anti-ulcer medications. As it is contagious, the horse needs to be kept away from other horses (isolation), you need to use disinfectant foot baths, individual thermometers, disposable gloves, separate equipment and hand washing after handling the affected horse.

I wanted to relay my story as initially we thought we were dealing with colic. I spent \$8,500 in 8 days at Werribee Vet Hospital to be told they weren't sure what was wrong with Charm. I then took her to Jim Vasey at Shepparton Vet Hospital where blood and fecal tests were run and EcoV was diagnosed for a further \$6000. I am grateful to Jim and Sandy Cornell for finding an answer.

As Charm had not been off my property except to do one of our training days at Gladysdale and later I judged, I put her in a small paddock as I didn't want to leave her tied up to the float for a few hours. I didn't notice how much manure was in the paddock until I started to clean it later before I took Charm home. I can't stress the importance of cleaning yards and paddocks at our competition venues. It was a costly experience for me and Charm.

I must say this virus is rare. Take care when using equine facilities x Viv
