International News

Isabell Werth Wins Second Leg of 2009 World Dressage Masters in Munich



The second leg of the 2009 World Dressage Masters, staged at the former Olympic Stadium of Munich, produced some great sport with winners representing the leading dressage countries of the world, Germany and The Netherlands. Thirty-eight year old Dutchman Sander Marijnissen took the win in the Grand Prix Special aboard his huge Dutch bred Moedwil (Goodwill x Beaujolais) with a 71.500% score. German Olympian Isabell Werth (39) did a great job showing her strong and talented Hanoverian Satchmo in the Freestyle to music.

Satchmo's owner, Mrs Madeleine Winter-Schulze, hurried from the Show Jumping Derby in Hamburg to fly in on time in Munich to witness her favourite pair Isabell and Satchmo.

"To me, Isabell and Satchmo combine the ultimate knowledge of riding. I love their skills, their art and I love them as a person and as a horse," Madeleine Winter-Schulze said. Isabell took the win scoring 84.750%. Germany's most victorious rider praised the show in all its details.

She admitted that the three mistakes for which she was penalized in the World Cup Finals Freestyle were rare exceptions in the career of the 15-year-old Hanoverian gelding. The mistakes in Las Vegas, she said, resulted from rider errors. "I was not focused." In Munich in front of the ecstatic Bavarian crowd she was!

Talk of the Day



Sander Marijnissen could not stop talking about his experiences. Next to his Grand Prix Special win he also celebrated the two small tour victories with his youngster Sander. "I can hardly believe what has happened this weekend," Sander said. "My Grand Prix result was a personal record. And to be able to learn and be within the group of the best riders of the world is amazing. I even have the feeling that despite my age of 38 I'm still improving! I was able to concentrate from one horse to the other within the shortest time and even peak on both! Moedwil impresses the audience with his relaxation and lightness. German coach Holger Schmezer stood next to my wife Karina. He was so happy with my result that he immediately embraced her to share his compliments."

Sander Marijnissen was the talk of the day, explaining that his father used to work as a postman and now helps him build up his own riding stable while working at an international dressage career. His wins were rewarded with AUD\$20,000 for the Grand Prix Special.

EFA Corner

Dressage Sub-Committee May 2009 Report

Apologies for not getting the March report into the newsletter!! I was hindered by my hospital visit and then my trip to Lexington. Never seems to be enough time in our days.



In March, there was a lot of discussion about the *Dressage and Jumping with the Stars* event. This has now come and gone and it seems, by all reports, to have run very successfully. At this weeks meeting (May) we received the final financials and the event made over \$17,000.00. The *Dressage Festival* in December made over \$11,000.00. This news was received with a great deal of satisfaction and thanks went to Caroline Coleby for her role as Director of Events. Caroline then replied with a motion to thank all the volunteers for their efforts, saying that without them, this result would not be possible. It was hoped that the thank-you notes and the free entry for the volunteers was appreciated. I did ask that for the next event, we organize a video of all the Master Classes and major events. We bring out these international visitors and I felt that we should ALL be able to benefit from their teachings. I attended the Sunday judges/coaches session with Ulf Mueller – and it was most worthwhile. The sub-committee voted to have the next event videoed.

At the meeting in May we also had 3 submissions for the job of Event Director for the upcoming year's events. These include the *Dressage Festival* and *Dressage and Jumping with the Stars*. Candidates had 5 minutes to put their case to the committee and then a vote was taken. Caroline Coleby was unanimously re-elected.

Weather Policy

There was considerable discussion on the subject of extreme heat and a policy, which may be utilized. Club representatives had to go back to their committee to discuss and return with a decision. It has now been voted that each club should make their own policy to suit their environment and note this in the handbook or on their website. Some clubs have said cancellation at 38 degrees, or if there is a total fire ban in their area. Refunds will be as per the normal cancellation policy, as it was felt cancellation under these circumstances is no ones fault.



Bridle Numbers

As from July 1st, any dressage performance cards not validated for the new year of 09/10 will lose their bridle number. It was also decided that the first 100 numbers be held for interstate riders. So if you want to keep your bridle number, remember to get your cards and payments in early!



Arena One



Finally, it seems that progress has been made! Werribee Park National Equestrian Centre has had Peter Huxtable look at and quote on redoing the whole arena. He will remove the surface, provide gravel for the base, cut, curb and relay, and provide stabilizer and new sand surface. The EFA Dressage Sub-Committee is meeting the total cost of this. The work will be completed by December 09 ready for

the *Dressage Festival!!* So, all those volunteers who have assisted at the DF and D&JWTs can see their efforts go to providing a real improvement in the facilities for all of us who compete. This is your money at work.

Other Arenas

Berwick and Victorian Dressage Clubs have both committed to donate \$8000 for the upgrade of arenas 2 and 3. Other clubs are being asked to donate to assist in the upgrade of the remaining arenas. In order to encourage donations, Clubs that donate will receive substantial rebates on the hire of these arenas. They will also have naming rights to the arena and a seat with a name plaque at the end of the arena. Members may be asked to vote on Yarra Valley Dressage Club contributing to this project. Werribee Park does not have the funds to do this, so if the clubs do not, or cannot assist, the arenas will stay as they are. Please think about whether you would like to see your clubs money go towards upgrading one of these arenas and which would then be called the "Yarra Valley Dressage Arena".

New wooden surrounds are being used similar to those used in Europe. They can be easily removed for maintenance and in keeping the sand totally flat, are safe and attractive. If you would like to see these arenas, I have them on my computer and would be happy to send them to you if you contact me. Werribee Park NEC will provide major maintenance in smudging and leveling 3 times a year.

Vacancies on ADC and Chairperson – Vacancies have been filled by Lesley Sullivan, Cathie Drury-Klein and Susie Hoevenaars. They will remain on the committee until April 2011.

Implementation of new EFA Dressage Tests

We now all have the current U.S. tests, which have been adapted for use in Australia. There has been some discussion as to the length of these tests – most are longer than the old tests and therefore classes will not be able to run to 35 entries. Clubs may lose money due to loss of numbers. Judges will have to judge for longer! But, we are now stuck with these tests for the foreseeable future.

Fast Track for Judges

A fast track trial is underway with several FEI level riders and Level 2 Dressage Coaches applying.

Dressage Riders and Coach Educators

The ADC has established a working group to promote education focusing on training of Dressage horses. An update will be delivered at the next meeting.

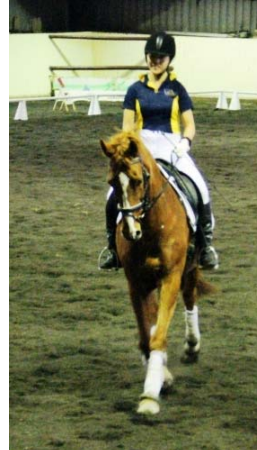

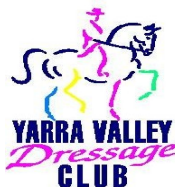

Newsletter Editor

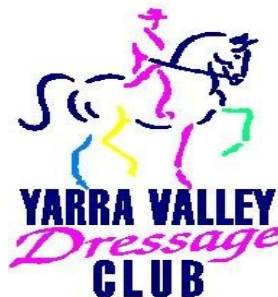
Prepare, format and edit information, advertising, and flyers for newsletter. Maintain email group list for distribution. Organise printing and posting of newsletters where needed.

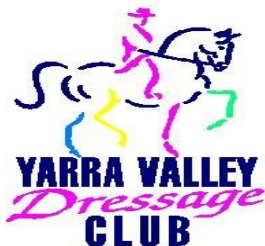
